Study on Homestead Food Production Marketing Officer

Since 1988, Helen Keller International (HKI) in Nepal has been providing technical assistance on a range of programs that include the government's National Vitamin A Program; prevention and treatment of trachoma; programs for visually impaired—inclusive education and livelihood opportunities; blindness prevention and curative treatment—and homestead food production for prevention of micronutrient deficiencies. HKI's current programming is designed to improve maternal, infant and young child nutrition through promotion of the Essential Nutrition Actions and by increasing the availability and utilization of nutrient-dense foods through Enhanced Homestead Food Production.

Background

HKI is managing the USAID funded, Suaahara II, integrated nutrition program with a consortium that addresses access to and promotion of diverse, nutrient-dense foods, quality health and nutrition practices, family planning and child spacing, water, sanitation and hygiene, governance and sociocultural factors including gender and social inclusion in 40 districts. The program specifically targets adolescent girls, pregnant and lactating women and children under two.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The intern will support HFP Marketing Specialist on program implementation and trainings in the districts. S/he will perform following specific tasks:

- Manage trainings at various districts, assign resource persons (RPs - training consultants) and communicate changes necessary as per RPs and district requirement.
- Support to prepare guidelines related to HFP Marketing, Saving & Credit and group mobilization and other field level trainings.
- Develop, revise and review guidelines for participant selection and activity implementation on HFP Marketing
- Maintain comprehensive report for training activities implementation in the district.
- Ensure assistance in meeting/workshops and trainings
- Interact with HFP Marketing Officers and HFP Officers to ensure cooperation and coordination in sustaining HFP programs and functions for VMF sustainability
- May be asked to monitor, communicate and receive district information/activities/trainings.
- Perform HFP Marketing related duties as assigned.
